

## Sparkling & Champagne

NV Amadio, Black label sparkling Brut, Adelaide Hills, SA 9/30  
This is an elegant sparkling with vibrant stone fruit flavours, complemented by a yeasty complexity and natural acidity leading to a crisp, structured finish.

NV Amadio, Grand Reserve Sparkling Brut, Adelaide Hills, SA 45  
Produced in the classical Methode Champenoise this stunning Sparkling Wine displays all those characters of only the premium French Champagnes. Apricot nougat aromas are subtle. The dry acidic finish with a smooth creamy palate leaves a lingering honey biscuit character.

2008 Pipers Brook, sparkling brut, Tasmania 12/45  
This sparkling has all the hallmarks of a great cool maritime climate, with subtle honey and lemon sherbet and all balanced with gentle sea side aromas.

NV Louis Roederer, premium Brut, France 90  
It is a full, complex champagne that is both modern and powerfull, whilst remaining a great classic

2011 Brockenchack 'Great Scott' sparkling shiraz, Eden Valley, Barossa 40  
This is a fun, approachable sparkling Shiraz, with rich ripe plum and dark cherry aromas, with a cleansing full bodied flavour.

## White

2013 Brockenchack, Mackenzie William 1896, Riesling, Barossa 9/35  
Grown on 119 year old vines, with subtle flavours of any lemon and lime with a hint of ginger with a crisp clean back palate finish.

2012 La Linea 'Vertigo' Riesling, Adelaide Hills, SA 30  
It's an off dry style or slightly sweet: you choose the term that works best for you! It shows powerful varietal fruit in the lemon/lime juice spectrum, with a floral and tropical background.

2013 Rockford, White Frontignac, Barossa Valley, SA 40  
This is a zippy refreshing young wine, clean and crisp with hint of green apple.

2011 Domaines Schlumberger "Les Princes Abbés" Gewurztraminer, France 50  
The colour is clear golden yellow with green reflections, of good intensity. The nose is open, pleasant and intense exotic fruits, grapefruit, lychee and mango. Airing enhances the previous aromas and reveals spices, candied ginger and peppermint. Once again, the nose expresses a beautiful ripeness and perfect health, resulting in a high class Gewurztraminer.

2014 Two Hands "Brilliant Disguise" Moscato, Barossa Valley, SA 500ml 9/25  
Taken from a white frontignac vineyard and produced in a Moscato style. Deliciously sweet, fizzy and fun to drink.

2013 Yalumba, Viognier, Eden Valley, Barossa 40  
This wine is what the essence of Viognier is all about, apricot fruit aromas with long luscious texture and hints of orange oil to finish.

2013 Amadio, Black label, Semillon Sauvignon Blanc, SA 9/30  
This is a finely balanced blend of two great white varieties. Semillon and Sauvignon Blanc. Displaying aromas of fruit salad with hints of passion fruit and cut grass, with tropical fruit flavours finishing light and clean. A delightful wine with seafood, a light starter or appetizer.

## White

- 2013 Leeuwin Estate, 'Silblings' Sauvignon Blanc Semillon, WA 40  
Savoury, fragrant and complex, a myriad of aromas and primary fruits. Leeuwin Estate is arguably one of the best vineyards in Australia and the wine shows this.
- 2014 Catalina Sounds, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, NZ 10/35  
Soft and approachable, with citrus and white stonefruit drive interwoven with tropical fruits and herbal notes.
- 2013 Te Mata "Cape Crest" Sauvignon Blanc, Hawkes Bay, NZ 45  
The palate is very long, dry, and concentrated, with great depth of lime, currant, and pear flavours, sea salt and a fresh acid tension that lasts for minutes. Simply fantastic.
- 2014 Shaw & Smith Sauvignon Blanc, Adelaide Hills, SA 42  
The 2014 is lively and aromatic with notes of passionfruit, nashi pear, and nettles. On the palate there is intense flavor, with fresh, limey fruit, mouthwatering acidity, and remarkable purity. It is bone dry and unoaked to maintain freshness.
- 2014 Forty-Two Degrees South, Pinot Grigio, Frogmore Creek, Tas 10/35  
Fresh lily aromas follow by ripe apricot flavours. Medium sweetness, full and intense mouth feel, balanced with a delicate creamy finish.
- 2014 Black Cottage, Pinot Gris, Marlborough, NZ 12/45  
This wine has enticing aromas of sweet pear, ripe apple and subtle spice. The lively palate features characters of melon and peach, with a smooth, supple mouth feel.
- 2013 Pipers Brook, Estate Chardonnay, Tasmania 45  
Delicate and steely aromas, lush green fruits, apple, pear, citrus and limes, washed river bed quartz, vanilla bean spice from fermentation in fine French oak barriques. The palate is clean, fresh, vibrant and mineral tight, a new direction in style for the estate chardonnay, and only some malolactic fermentation has led this wine down a path of rejuvenated elegance, rather than that of the fat and full style of yesteryear.
- 2013 Te Mata Woodthorpe, Chardonnay, Hawkes Bay, NZ 12/40  
The palate shows great intensity with perfectly ripe stonefruit flavours over a background of rich, salted shortbread and a long, concentrated, very fine finish.
- 2013 Shaw & Smith, M3 Chardonnay, Adelaide Hills, SA 50  
M3 is at the forefront of the ongoing refinement and evolution of Australian Chardonnay. Simply delicious.
- 2012 Balgownie "Estate" Chardonnay, Bendigo, Vic 55  
This wine is a wonderful balance between perfectly ripened fruit characters and balanced acidity, with delicate oak notes. The palate exhibits great concentration from beautiful old vine fruits.
- 2012 Amadio "Christian's" Reserve Chardonnay, Adelaide Hills 65  
This complex aged Chardonnay displays aromas of rich white peach and nectarine with hints of kaffir lime and pink grapefruit. Seven months maturation in French Oak Barrels, imparting subtle hints of honey roasted cashew.

## Red

- 2013 Brockenchack, Tru-Su Rosé, Eden Valley Barossa 9/30  
This is a straight shiraz with 8 hours skin contact, with aromas of fairy floss and over ripe strawberry front palate and soft dry finish
- 2011 Amadio, Heritage selection, Sagrantino, Adelaide Hills, SA 55  
Intensely juicy aromas, rhubarb, stewed fruits, cherry, raspberry, all those bright red and full flavoured fruits. A very jammy finish with subtle tannins and acid. Really great wine to appreciate on its own, possibly even chilled down slightly on a hot summers day.
- 2013 Nanny Goat Vineyard, Pinot Noir, Central Otago, NZ 12/40  
The entry to the palate is rich, with sweet berry fruits nicely balanced by mouth-watering juicy acidity
- 2013 Pipers Brook, Estate Pinot Noir, Tasmania 45  
A diverse range of concentrated berry flavours, It could only be Tasmanian, sweet vibrant berry fruits, floral and spice, the palate is finely stated, concentrated with depth and weight, dark fruit cake, sweet fleshy cranberries and cherries, the long delicate flavours explore your palate with excitement.
- 2013 Nanny Goat Vineyards "Super Nanny" Pinot Noir, Centarl Otago, NZ 50  
Every year one or two parcels of fruit stand head and shoulders above the rest and this is it, hand picked and sorted, 15 months in new French oak, ripely scented of plum and cherry flavours
- 2013 Tolpuddle, Pinot Noir, Tasmania 80  
This is a beautifully aromatic and textured Pinot Noir, with intensity, power, purity and complexity
- 2013 Te Mata, Gamay Noir, Hawkes Bay, NZ 35  
An absolute fruit bomb, the palate is ripe and juicy, with a mix of black and red berries and cherries, and refreshing, silky tannins that extend the finish.
- 2011 Amadio, heritage selection, Montepulciano, Adelaide Hills 60  
Montepulciano is a grape variety widely planted throughout the central regions of Italy, most notably Abruzzi. Montepulciano ripens late and produces rich full flavours with good acidity levels and soft ripe tannins.
- 2010 Castillo Labastida, Tempranillo, Rioja, Spain 35  
This wine was aged in 3-year-old American oak casks and 2-year-old French oak casks. Red berries, cocoa, liquorice, slight smell of spices and liqueur. Red berry confit, macerated Morello cherries and a slightly fatty tactile sensation.
- 2011 Amadio, Heritage selection, Aglianico, Barossa Valley SA 55  
Similar in style to the Amadio Sagrantino, this wine offers ripe fruit aromas and flavours but with darker fruit characteristics than that of its Italian counterpart. More black cherry as opposed to raspberry and riper red fruit flavours. Substantial but very fine grain tannins, complimented well by the acid to produce an intense all round mouth-feel.
- 2006 Fire Gully, Cabernet/Merlot, Margret River, WA 12/40  
The 2006 Fire Gully Cab Merlot is showing some restraint on the nose, gently perfumed red berry aromatics, opening onto a palate that has ripe plum and blackcurrant flavours.

- 2012 Printhe, Merlot, Orange, N.S.W 9/30  
This merlot has a bright ruby colour, the aromatic intensity is quite high and displays red fruits with Turkish delight and cedar oak
- 2012 Sticks, Cabernet Sauvignon, Yarra Valley, Vic 10/35  
This wine is so easy to drink. It has Hints of Red Current, Blackberry, cinnamon and chocolate. Perfect with a fine cut of beef.
- 2012 Penley Estate "Phoenix" Cabernet Sauvignon, Coonawarra, SA 40  
This wine shows dominance of spicy cabernet fruit, a dense ripeness with hints of smokey oak. A wine made to enjoy young, ripe and elegant, distinct Coonawarra cabernet characteristics.
- 2014 Two Hands 'Sexy Beast' Cabernet Sauvignon, McLaren Vale, SA 55  
Lovely energy and density across the palate. Flavours mirror the aroma with everything in proportion with lovely balance. A premium Cabernet Sauvignon that deserves the finest of foods.
- 2012 Balgownie "Estate" Cabernet Sauvignon, Bendigo, Vic 60  
This a classic Bendigo Cabernet, bright rich berry fruits with a hint of mint and eucalypt.
- 2010 Rockford "Rifle Range" Cabernet Sauvignon, Barossa Valley, SA 65  
The 'Biscay' soil of these vineyards is heavy clay, lending the wine its full flavour and earthy tones. A wet 2011 winter gave a great start to the 2012 vintage. Fruit ripened with ease. The flavours are intense, concentrated and well balanced.
- 2012 Yangarra, Old vine Grenache, McLaren Vale, SA 40  
*A highly complex, intense beauty, with cherry and plums giving way to hints of licorice, dried spring flowers, cocoa and cinnamon spice. The palate is driven and concentrated*
- 2012 Yalumba "the Signature" Cabernet Sauvignon/Shiraz, Barossa, Vic 60  
Almost blood red, this is a Cabernet Sauvignon & Shiraz in motion, changing and shifting from red scents of currants and cranberries to the black fruits of plum compote and black cherries, before a touch of cedar, leafy herbs and powdery black spices freshen the finish.
- 2011 Yalumba, FDR 1A, Cabernet Sauvignon/shiraz, Eden Valley, Barossa 70  
The 2011 FDR1A was sourced entirely from Eden Valley vineyards. With the brooding aromas of dark cassis, red fruits and spices and finally the sublime perfumed floral aromatics of violets and sweet cherries.
- 2012 Amadio, Black label, Shiraz, Adelaide Hills, SA 9/30  
This is a powerful Aussie red with plenty of Shiraz fruit flavour and supportive oak tannins. Intense plum and raspberry fruit aromas with subtle hints of liquorice, cedar and spice. Spicy tannins on the finish.
- 2013 Brockenchack "Zip Line Shiraz" Eden Valley, Barossa 10/39  
this Shiraz is traditionally made by partially crushing the grapes into open top fermenters with 8 – 10 days on skins. It is then basket pressed and left to mature in seasoned French oak hogsheads for 18 months. To be enjoyed now and for years to come - just like the zip line cable ride at the vineyard,
- 2012 Yangarra, Shiraz, McLaren Vale, SA 40  
The 2012 is a classic Yangarra Shiraz, with bright black fruits and black peppercorn spice. There are layers of complexity with chocolate and charcuterie, woven together with fine grainy tannins.
- 2010 Brockenchack "Jack Harrison" Shiraz, Eden Valley, Barossa 75  
The shiraz is hand picked from 90 year old vines, aged for 24 months in new French oak. Being only a stones throw from the Hill of Grace patch you can expect a cracking drop.

## Vintage and Cellar collection

1998	Haan Merlot Prestige, Barossa Valley, SA	75
A very powerful wine in both aroma and palate structure, with aromas of ripe plum and black cherry which carry over on the palate to further emphasise the silky oak and fruit tannins.		
2002	Elderton, "Ode to Lorraine" Cabernet/Shiraz/Merlot, Barossa, SA	80
A rich dark purple wine, with fantastic chocolate, berry and licorice aromas, amazing balance between power and elegance.		
2007	Amadio, D3/v14 Reserve Merlot, Adelaide hills, SA	60
This paramount clone of D3/v14 Merlot displays lifted aromatics of blackcurrant jam, wild raspberry, quince and white pepper, articulated onto the palate with layers of spice. The finish evokes dark cherry and red plum, adding the finesse to a savoury yet complex lingering palate.		
2005	Bethany "BinGR11" Shiraz, Barossa Valley, SA	90
This Shiraz is bursting with ripe plum and blackberry characters on both the nose and palate.		
2006	Bethany "BinGR10" Shiraz, Barossa Valley, SA	90
An iconic Barossa winemaking family, only producing 4,500 bottles each year, with 2006 being one of the best years ever in the Barossa.		
2009	Elderton, "Command Shiraz" Barossa Valley, SA	140
This wine won the best Shiraz in the world at the London international wine and spirit competition, say no more.		
2010	Brockenchack "William Fredericks" Shiraz, Eden Valley, Barossa	155
Very small batch of the most premium fruit handpicked with 30 months on new French oak, one of the most well rounded and balanced Shiraz on the market.		
2010	Two Hands "two Worlds" Shiraz Cabernet 1.5L	400
A very limited release of the finest Barossa Shiraz, with the finest Napa Valley Cabernet, the result is a big, sweet and coating fruit mouth feel with very fine tannins.		
2010	Two Hands "My Hands" Barossa Valley Shiraz	600
Hand picked on the 24 <sup>th</sup> February 2010 and only 1600 bottles produced
